Mission: Little Hands Virginia helps to provide essentials and a little extra love to young children (0-3 years) and moms in need in Central Virginia.

Model: Working with our network of local agencies, shelters, hospitals and other nonprofits, we identify the needs of families in the cities of Richmond, Hopewell and Petersburg, and counties of Charles City, Chesterfield, Hanover, Henrico, Goochland, and New Kent. Our model relies on the donation of new and “nearly new” items through grassroots community drives and donations. We sort and bundle items, and deliver them to parents and children through our network of partners.

How we work with our partners:

Client Specific: We help provide identified items specific to a client/patient/individual’s needs. For example, a mom your organization works with just had a new baby and she needs certain items. The partner can fill out the online request form and we will work to fulfill the list of items. The request can be delivered to your office, or a pick up/drop off location can be arranged with assistance from our network of volunteers.

Need Specific: We help provide more general items needed by an organization. For example, your organization regularly needs diapers. Through our donation drives and fundraising efforts, we will assist in helping supply your organization with the items it needs. Through the online request form, your organization can identify the item(s) you need, how many, and how often and we will work to fulfill the request and deliver the items to your organization.

How to become a partner: Email us! We are open to partnering with any organization that directly serves parents and young children (0-3) in the Central Virginia region. Once an organization expresses interest in partnering with us, we will discuss needs and how we can best be of assistance. About Us: Little Hands Virginia is a nonprofit that was founded in 2019 by Taylor Keeney, a mom of two little ones who by day does communications and advocacy consulting for Hunton Andrews Kurth. Taylor quickly recognized there was a gap in support for young children in need in the Greater Richmond community and founded Little Hands to ensure all children in Central Virginia have the ability to thrive from “Day 1.”

Little Hands Virginia currently works with over 30 partner organizations in the region, including local social service agencies, hospitals, homeless shelters, prisoner reentry programs, school districts, law enforcement, and many other nonprofits.
